

UC Life! Club Alcohol Policy

Clubs must contact UC Life! and obtain a UC liquor licence before holding on campus alcohol based events.

The following are the guidelines relevant to Clubs when advertising a function at which alcohol will be served:

- Advertising for attendance at the function should not include any details of free, discounted or reduced price alcohol;
- Clubs should be aware of the duty of care which they have to members, UC Life! and the community and ensure that functions are conducted in an appropriate manner;
- Free, discounted, or reduced price alcohol should not be offered at any function be it on or off campus;
- The availability of non-alcoholic beverages should be displayed in any event advertising
- As per responsible services of alcohol, food should be available at all functions where alcohol is served;
- Any advertising must not include phrases such as:
 - 'happy hour'
 - 'cheap drinks'
 - 'discounted drinks'
 - 'free drinks'

which may indicate that drinks will be free or at a reduced price for any period of time.

Any example of an allowable phrasing is:

'Price per ticket includes alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages'

- The use of other names for any alcoholic beverages (e.g. \$2 Tarzans or \$1 Janes) is not allowed.
- The use of 'all you can drink events', 'sculling competitions' or similar is not allowed.
- Should clubs have functions external to UC Life! then it is highly recommended that bar staff working at the event are familiar with "the National Guidelines for Responsible Serving of Alcohol."

Failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in compromising the responsible club's funding ability for the following year

If you intend to sell alcohol at a club function external to UC Life! then you must satisfy the relevant sections of the Liquor Act 1975.
